How personal data is stored by the CWD Team

Personal data of students is stored by the CWD Team in Northumbria's student record systems including spreadsheets and shared drives located on Northumbria's servers. Access to personal data is restricted to those members of staff who have a requirement to maintain a relationship with you, and is controlled through user security profiles. All University employees, contractors and volunteers that are given access to personal data receive mandatory Data Protection training and have a contractual responsibility to maintain confidentiality.

How personal data is processed by the CWD Team

Personal data is processed by the CWD Team to comply with contractual obligations in relation to funding by HEE.
