STATE-OF-THE-ART SIMULATED TEACHING ENVIRONMENTS.

At Northumbria University our clinical skills facility trains hundreds of nurses, midwives, allied health professionals, teachers and social workers every year. Delivering everything from undergraduate study and degree apprenticeships to continued professional development training for those already working in professional practice, our experts work to prepare our students for the fast-changing working environment by utilising the latest simulation and virtual reality technology.

With the support of external funding, we plan to almost double our simulated skills space which is used to educate our public professionals. The new state-of-the-art facility will be one of the best facilities of its kind in the UK. It will allow us to continue to prepare our students for real-world scenarios and improve patient safety by giving them the tools they need to do their job effectively whether that's before they join the workforce or for those already working in it.


HIGHER EDUCATION WITHOUT BARRIERS.
